

## Shooter of the Year Award

Each year, archers throughout the state of Alaska compete for the Shooter of the Year title. The winner is determined by adding up percentages from the highest five of the seven “Shooter of the Year” shoots throughout the year. The shooter with the highest total is crowned as Shooter of the Year. The seven shoots (listed below) include a variety of archery disciplines, including 3D (marked and unmarked), NFAA Indoor, NFAA Field, Indoor FITA and Outdoor FITA.

In past years only one Shooter of the Year title was given and, since the highest scores are most typically shot in the Unlimited (Freestyle) class, in recent years the title has gone exclusively to Unlimited class shooters. However, starting 2008 it was decided to represent the largest class of archers in the Alaska by offering a separate Shooter of the Year award for Bowhunter Freestyle shooters.

### Youth Shooter of the Year

The ASAA offers a \$300 savings bond to the youth shooter who amasses the highest percentage total at five of the seven of the shooter of the year shoots.

Any shooter (including youths) must attend at least 5 of the seven Shooter of the Year shoots to be eligible. Percentages for the highest five of the seven shoots will be added together.

Shooter of the Year shoots are:

Spring Bear (Marked 3D)	(Mat-Su College)
State 3D (unmarked)	(Black Sheep/Kincaid)
Independence Shoot (marked 3D)	(Soldotna)
NFAA State Field	(Kincaid Park, Anchorage)
State Outdoor FITA	(Fairbanks)

The schedule for shoots, including the Shooter of the Year shoots, will be set at our fall meeting in November of each year.
